Y a-t-il un auxiliaire dans ma phrase affirmative?

AUXILIAIRES:
to be (am, is, are, was, were)
to have (si suivi d'un participe passé: has, have, had)
to do (do, does, did)
would, could, should, will, can, may, might, must

OUI

NON

J'inverse le sujet et l'auxiliaire

Je regarde le temps du verbe dans ma phrase affirmative

Exemple:
I am sick
=
Am I sick?

mon verbe est au présent

mon verbe est au passé

je choisis **DO** si le pronom devant le verbe est: I, you, we, they

je choisis **DOES** si le pronom devant le verbe est: he, she, it

je choisis **DID**

N'OUBLIE PAS LE POINT D'INTERROGATION A LA FIN DE LA PHRASE

j'écris ma phrase de la façon suivante:
do+sujet+verbe+restant de la phrase?

j'écris ma phrase de la façon suivante:
does+sujet+verbe+restant de la phrase?

j'écris ma phrase de la façon suivante:
did+ sujet +verbe+restant de la phrase

Exemple:
I eat spaghetti
=
do I eat spaghetti?

Exemple:
He eats spaghetti
=
Does he eat spaghetti?

ATTENTION le verbe revient à l'**infinitif**, donc pas d'accord

Exemple:
He ate spaghetti
=
Did he eat spaghetti?

PAST PARTICIPLE

Been For example: I have been
I have been drinking

VERB TO HAVE

PRESENT TENSE

I	have

PAST TENSE

I	had
You	had

They	had

PAST PARTICIPLE

Had For example: I have had

VERB TO DO

PRESENT TENSE

I	do
You	do
He, she, it	does
We	do

They	do

PAST TENSE

I	did
You	did
He, She, it	did
We	did
You	did
They	did

PAST PARTICIPLE

Done For example: I have done
